

# Moslem Youth Objects To Army, Talked Into It

A 22-year-old Brooklyn artist who refused to be inducted into the Army yesterday on the grounds that being a soldier would conflict with his Moslem religion, changed his mind after he was arrested by the FBI and got some advice from a leader of the Islamic faith.

York Cunningham, 22, a Negro of 535 Greene Ave., was seized at the induction center at 44 Whitehall St. While awaiting arraignment before U. S. Commissioner Edward W. McDonald, Cunningham had a talk with Shaik Daoud Ahmed Faisal, spiritual leader of the Islamic Mission of America, who set him right.

Cunningham was released when he promised McDonald that he would appear for induction today.
